Champion of Champions Conditions of Entry and Competition

1. About

The first Champion of Champions was played in September 1945 at Yarra Yarra Golf Club. In 1956 it was reduced from a 36 hole event to a 27 hole event. In 2013 it was reduced to an 18 hole event.

2. Competition

Champion of Champions Stroke 18 holes - **Open to Club Champions Only**

Minor Champions Stroke 18 holes - automatic to Club Champions handicaps 18 and over.

League Championship Nett and Gross 18 holes for players with handicaps 36 and under.

If a Championship player has increased her handicap to 37 or over after entering the competition, she will be required to play off 36.

In the event of a tie in a Gross event the winner shall be decided by a sudden death play-off. A referee who is not affiliated with either club involved will accompany the players. The Championship Nett event winner shall be decided by a count back

3. Eligibility

- Open to any affiliated VGL Golf Club
- Competitors must be financial for at least 3 months and hold a current Golf Australia Handicap.

4. Entries

5. Trophies

Trophies will be awarded to:

- Champion of Champions – Best Gross Overall
- Minor League Champion – Best Gross Overall (18+ Handicap)
- League Champion – Best Gross
- League Champion – Best Nett

6. Registration Players are asked to arrive at the golf course at least 30 minutes prior to the stipulated tee time

7. Conditions of Competition

Standard Conditions of Entry for all VGL Events apply.

- All competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Club of St Andrews Scotland, subject to local rules that are in force at the course where the tournament is conducted.
- A player must hold a Golf Australia Handicap to be eligible to compete. Golf Link Numbers must be provided on Entry Forms for all players.
- Any disputes and protests will be decided by the VGL Match Committee whose decision will be final.
- The VGL Match Committee makes all arrangements, and has full power to alter the conditions, should they deem it desirable and will have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- Motorised transportation is prohibited. Exceptions: a) If a player has obtained the age of 70 may use ride on motorised cart without needing to apply for exemption. b) If a player has a permanent disability or is recovering from serious injury or illness and is unable to play without the use of a motorised vehicle or bike, the player must obtain a doctor's certificate and apply to the Victorian Golf League for approval.
- Penalty: Refer Rules of Golf Appendix 1, Part C, 9
- Exception: Rules officials may use a motorised vehicle to transport a player in the interests of pace of play where necessary without penalty
- Players must check with the course Professional before use as some courses do not permit the use of personal carts.
- All competitors must comply with the dress code of the course.
- Entries will be refunded at the discretion of the VGL Executive.
- Competitors must be ready to start at the appointed time. If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is loss of the first hole in match play or two strokes at the first hole in stroke play instead of disqualification.
- The results of ties shall be determined by the VGL Executive in accordance with Golf Australia Policy.
- The same player cannot win both gross and nett trophies.
- The use of mobile phones by a competitor or his caddie whilst on a golf course is distracting and inconsiderate. If the competitor or caddie is in possession of a mobile phone it must be on silent or turned off. A player or caddie cannot receive or make calls during the match - Penalty - Disqualification. Receiving (ONLY) and viewing Short Message Services (SMS), between the playing of holes, is not considered receiving or making phone calls" during the match. Exception: Players/caddies are permitted to make phone calls from the course to the clubhouse or to event officials for rules/emergency assistance.
- A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance ONLY. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring devices that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his/her play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, club selection etc) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which penalty is DISQUALIFICATION regardless of whether any such function is actually used.

If entries exceed limit, the last names from clubs with several players will be declined in order of receipt.
